NEFAB Safety Policy

Safety Policy Statement

Via systematic employment of safety management principles NEFAB aims to establish the highest possible and uniform level of ATM safety within its member states and strive to continuously improve it.

Commitment of senior management

All levels of management in NEFAB member states, NSAs and ANSPs are committed, via NEFAB Council, to providing sufficient resources to achieve the highest possible level of safety performance within NEFAB.

Responsibilities and accountabilities

NEFAB member states are responsible for implementing the appropriate legislatory arrangements to enable the necessary co-operation and other practical procedures to be developed, including common airspace policy, civil-military co-operation and performance plans.

NEFAB NSAs are responsible for establishing appropriate NSA arrangements and co-operation agreements for the safe and effective implementation of NEFAB in all relevant areas of co-operation, including supervision of ANSPs and harmonization of applicable procedures.

NEFAB ANSPs are responsible for increasing the harmonization of safety management systems. ANSPs are responsible for enhancing ANSP co-operation within different operational areas, including airspace, ATS provision, ANS support and systems support.

NEFAB Council is responsible for implementing the necessary arrangements to ensure the fulfillment of NEFAB objectives. These include e.g. supporting the development and implementation of a common safety management system by the ANSPs and harmonization of applicable rules and procedures within NSAs and ANSPs.

The NEFAB Safety Policy was approved and adopted by the NEFAB Council on [27 November 2014]
